FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT

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Introduction

Curricular feedback is regularly collected from different stakeholders of the institution to ensure consistent improvement in the teaching –learning process. The institution adopts offline method for collecting feedback. The IQAC ensures the timely collection and analysis of the feedback collected. Results are communicated to various parties of interest for taking actions if required.

The feedback committee is constituted by IQAC, and this committee initiates the process of feedback collection. The feedback from teachers and students was collected Feedbacks collected were analysed using quantitative methods and the results were presented as a report before the management and principal for further actions. Comparison of feedback results with the previous years has helped the institution in continuously improving the teaching learning process.

The detailed analysis of results and action taken report is presented in the next sections.

Student's Feedback on Campus

Academic year 2023-24

Students Feedback was collected by the Feedback committee on various aspects of the college like library, extracurricular activities etc. A questionnaire prepared with about 12 questions was randomly distributed among students from different programmes as BA, BSc, BBA and BCA. The students rated the differently facilities on the campus on 5 different scales provided in the Feedback form. **Feedback analysis report**

Students were in general satisfied with the facilities provided by the college campus like the sports facilities, library, NSS, NCC support from the teaching and administration members. They shared that the college environment helped in development of their personality.

- 1) In the question where students were asked about Admission procedure , majority of the students (59.05%) rated as excellent and 29.50% student said it was good
- 2) In the question about support from teaching faculty 62.34% students strongly agreed it to be excellent while 26.70% rated it to be very good.
- 3) When students were questioned about the library facilities 46.34% students agreed it to be excellent and 32.50% said it was very good.
- 4) On drinking water facility in campus the students 48.91% rated it as excellent while 37.68 % said it was very good.
- 5) When students were questioned about Cafeteria in the campus 43.54% students gave excellent remark while 38.9% said it to be very good.
 - 6) In the question on Campus security 54.67 % students agreed to be excellent and 35% have said to be very good.
- 7) Sanitation facility in the campus Majority of the students have rated it very good and % have given excellent opinion.
- 8) Common room facility % student rated this as excellent while % rated it as very good
- 9) When students were asked about the extracurricular activities majority of the students % has said it to be excellent and % student gave very good remark.
- 10) When students were questioned about the sport facility % gave very good rating while % said that the sport facility was excellent.
- 11) Information communication technology in the college was rated by % student as very good and % student as excellent
- 12) Overall rating about teaching , administration and infrastructure facilities .Majority of the students % has given excellent remark while % students said it to be very good. This indicates that there are adequate classrooms and well equipped laboratories as well as staff room common room, gymkhana, library, separate vehicle parking facility and a big playground in the college premises.
